Failure to re-register by the February 22, 2010 deadline may result in loss of a slot in the returning class for school year 2010-2011. Refer family and friends TODAY! Re-registration fee FOR ALL STUDENTS is \$250.00 NON REFUNDABLE. All tuition and other fees must be completed for the registration to be completed.
