**If DC Public School has a 2 hour late start on our 12:30 PM Dismissal days, St. Augustine Catholic School will be closed.**

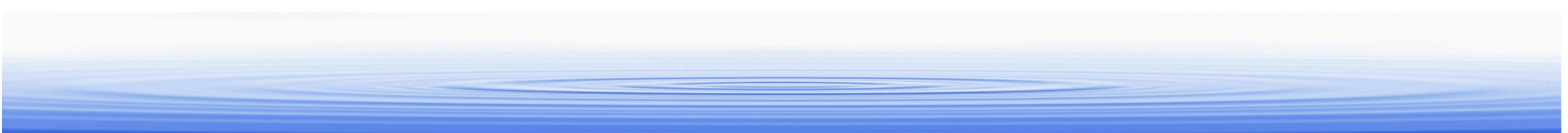
